
## Principles

  - One of a kind
- Sugar desktop
  - Simplistic but designed to grow with the user
  - Collaboration is a first-class citizen

#### Ethiopia

- Government project
- 5000 laptops, mostly in Addis Ababa
- 4 days of teacher training
- Not much electricity in classrooms
- Laptop software in English
- 1 textbook per class
- Monitoring & evaluation system
- Akili interactive textbook software








#### Paraguay

- Non-government project
- Support from public sector, private sector, government, and the community
- 4000 laptops in Caacupé
- 4 weeks of teacher training, during teacher vacations.
- Decent infrastructure
- Media outreach











### UK project

- Plan for the classrooms first
- Make parents feel part of the project
  - And partially responsible
- Be careful with expectations
- Be open
- Publicity is good
